



Cleaning



- You can just rinse off pollen, sand, and dust with some water (from a hose or watering can).
- For stubborn dirt, use a lint-free cloth or a soft sponge with plenty of water and a light touch.
- To get rid of really tough grime, use warm water and a bit of regular dish soap.



Stuff you should avoid:

- Don't rub your SunForm dry.
- Don't use any abrasive cleaners.
- Glass cleaners, solvents, and alcohol can damage the surface.
- Don't use a pressure washer.

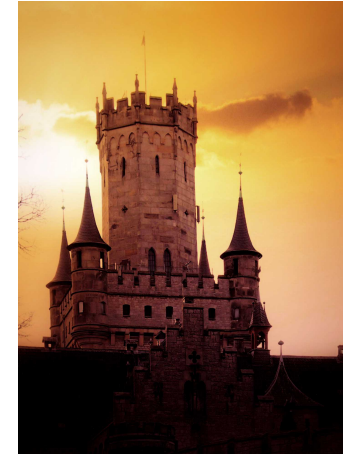
Safety Instructions



SunForms aren't toys and aren't suitable for kids under 3.
The mounting kit might contain small parts - **choking hazard**.

If you use brute force (like bending it too much or hitting it hard), the plastic discs might break or splinter. Broken edges can be sharp or pointy and might cause cuts or stabs if you're not careful.

In that case, please wear proper gear (like safety goggles and gloves).

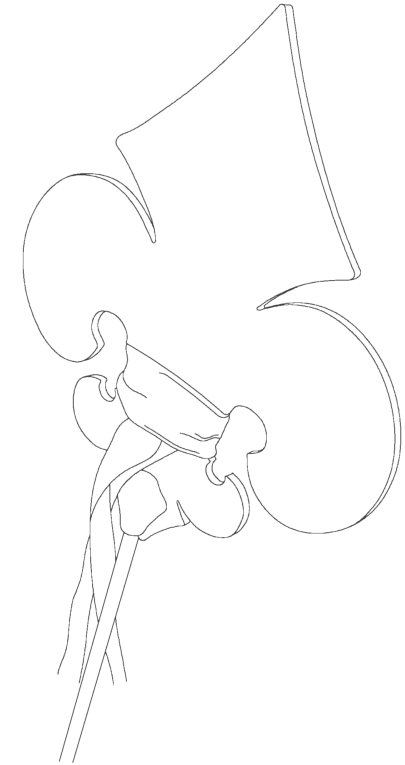

What's Included

General Info

- SunForms are winterproof and can easily handle temperatures up to 167 °F (75 °C).
- The discs come with a protective film. However, for satin or coated discs (MultiColor), this film is removed during manufacturing.
- **To keep the protective film from tearing around delicate engravings and thin edges, please peel it off as slowly as possible.**



Assembly

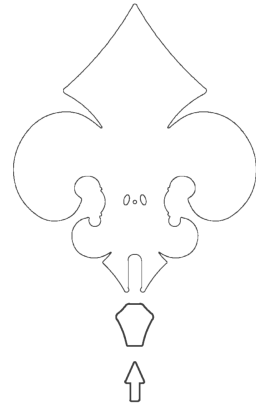
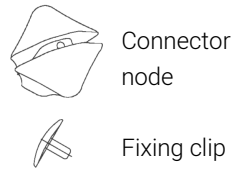
You won't need any tools to set up your SunForm.

1.

First, peel off the protective film. (The "Multi-Color" version is coated on one side, so the film on that side has already been removed).

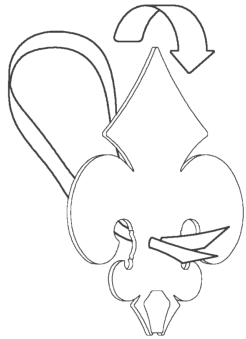
2.

Slide the connector node all the way into the slot on the lily until it stops.



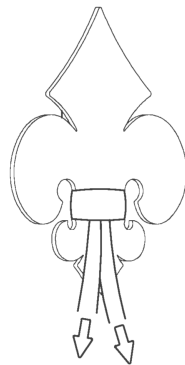
3.1

Feed both ends of the waistband through the oval holes. Loop the band forward over the front of the lily.



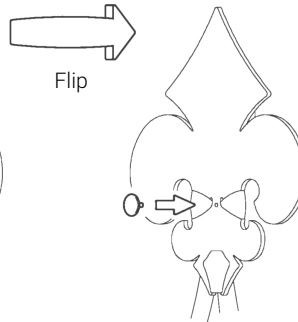
3.2

Slide the waistband into your preferred position. Place the edges of the band into the designated notches and pull it tight.



3.3

Insert the fixing clip (from the back) into the remaining center hole to lock the waistband in place.

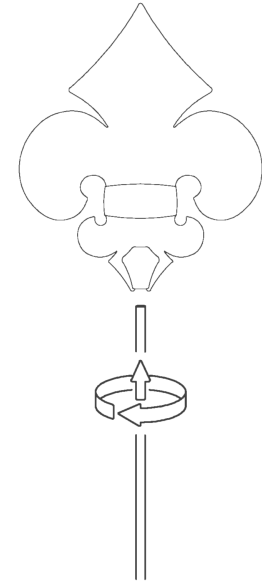


Tip

If you need to remove the fixing clip later, don't pull it from the back. Instead, push it back out using the pin that sticks through on the front side.

4.

Insert the swinging rod into the connector node from below using a twisting motion. Push it all the way in until it stops (about 0.85 inches / 22 mm).



Setup

Suncatchers need daylight, but they actually prefer shady spots without direct sunlight.

You can simply push the rod of this SunForm into the ground. For harder soil and light wind, about 6 inches (15 cm) deep is enough. If the soil is on the softer side or you expect stronger winds, the rod should go about 8 to 10 inches (20 to 25 cm) deep.

Make sure the swinging motion of the rod doesn't loosen or widen the soil around it, as this weakens its hold. If it does, just pull the rod out and push it back into the ground a little bit to the side.

Cleaning

(Waistband)

- Please don't toss the waistband into the washing machine - stick to hand washing.
- When ironing, use a low temperature, cover the band with a pressing cloth, and make sure to avoid heating up the built-in clip.
